Rule 13.9

A player who scores a goal must immediately drop her stick to allow the umpire to confirm it is legal. A player must not adjust the thongs of her crosse after an umpire requests to inspect her crosse.

Rule 13.9 Procedure after a goal has been scored

1. The **goal scorer** must drop her crosse immediately following the goal.
2. The **Lead Official** whistles and signals the goal. The game clock is stopped. If a 12 goal differential exists, the game clock will continue to run.
 - 2a. The **Lead Official** picks up the goal scorer's crosse and checks to ensure it is legal. All players on the field can move at this time.
 - 2b. The **C Official** ensures that, at the time of the goal, the attack players were onside and stays at the restraining line to monitor players who cross over it.
 - 2c. The **Deep Trail Official** manages the substitution area. No substitutes are allowed on or off the field, until the goal scorer's Crosse has been deemed legal.
3. If the Crosse is deemed **LEGAL**, the **Lead Official** resigns the goal (no whistle).
4. Play restarts with a centre draw.

IF the crosse is **ILLEGAL**

1. The **Lead Official** whistles and tells all players to "stand".
2. The **Lead Official** signals "no goal". She passes the illegal crosse to the Deep Trail Official who places it at the scorer's table, until it can be adjusted at half time, or at the end of the game.
3. The **player** that had the illegal crosse can get a replacement crosse from her team bench and returns to where she had the shot on goal.
4. The **C Official** manages the restraining line to ensure both teams are on-side before play is restarted. Players who crossed above the restraining line, must return behind the restraining line before play restarts.
5. The **Deep Trail Official** continues to ensure that no substitutes are made.
6. The **Goalkeeper** is given possession of the ball in her goal circle. All field players must be at least 4m from the goal circle before play is restarted.
7. The **Lead Official** whistles to restart play.
